Scheme of Examination : **PART-I:** There shall be two theory papers and practical/viva-voce examination as per following scheme.

Note: To pass the examination a candidate has to obtain minimum 40% marks in each theory paper and practical/ viva-voce separately and minimum 50% marks aggregate in all.

Revised ordinance No. 179

B.A.LL.B. FIVE YEARS INTEGRATED DEGREE COURSE
(Semester System)

1. The whole period of this integrated B.A. LL.B. course divided in to FIVE academic years/classes known as B.A.LL.B. Part-I, Part-II, Part-III, Part-IV and B.A.LL.B. Part-V respectively. Every year/Class is divided in to Two semesters WINTER and SUMMER semester. The examination of winter semester of all the classes will be called as WINTER TERM EXAMINATION and the other one would be known as SUMMER TERM EXAMINATION. In other words the course is extended in to TEN SEMESTERS. The first Semester of all the classes (winter semesters) are known as odd semesters (1, 3, 5, 7, 9) While The second semester of all the classes are called EVEN SEMESTERS collectively.
2. The detail syllabus/course of studies for each semester/academic year and marking scheme for examination etc. for this course shall be framed and approved by the Board of studies and Law faculty duly constituted in accordance with the provision of University statute and Act. The syllabus forming bodies can amend/modified the syllabus if needed in the light of BCI norms, time to time.
3. The semester academic schedule shall be framed by the University authorities according to the Guide Lines of BCI, and may be changed if needed. The General schedule* will be as follows for this course -

2. The Practical examination date will be confidential by HOD/Principal as the case may be

4. An applicant who has passed & successfully completed senior secondary school certificate course in 10+2 system or equivalent (such as 11+1, 'A' level in senior school leaving certificate) course recognized by the university or passed Higher secondary school Examination of Chhattisgarh Board of Higher secondary Examination Raipur with at least 45% of the total marks in case of General category and 40% of the total marks in the case of SC and ST in any stream and also fulfill the other institutional and state Government criteria shall be eligible for a admission in B.A.L.L.B. Part-I First Semester. The procedure for this admission shall be announced by the University administration every year.
5. Subject to the condition stipulated by a university on this behalf and the high degree of professional commitment required. The maximum age for seeking admission in this course is limited to twenty years in case of general category of applicant and twenty two years in case of applicants from SC/ST and Other backward communities on the 1st day of July every year.
6. If any applicant who fulfill the requirements of clause-4 and 5 and other process relating to admission and the has got admitted in part-I first semester and has prosecuted regular course of prescribed study for that semester session in the university school of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to appear at the B.A.L.L.B. Part-I first semester winter term Examination.
7. Subject to the conditions contained in clause (a) to (d)
 - (i) A candidate who after having passed B.A.L.L.B. Part-I, First Semester examination of the university has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the BALLB. Part-I Second semester summer term examination.
 - (ii) A candidate who after having passed B.A.L.L.B. Part-I, Second Semester examination of the university or of any other statutory university recognized as equivalent thereto, has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the B.A.L.L.B. Part-II First semester winter term examination.
 - (iii) A candidate who after having passed B.A.L.L.B. Part-II, First Semester examination of the university has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present

- himself/herself at the B.A.LL.B. Part-II Second semester summer term examination.
- (iv) A candidate who after having passed B.A.LL.B. Part-II, Second Semester examination of the university or of any other statutory university recognized as equivalent thereto, has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the B.A.LL.B. Part-III First semester winter term examination.
- (v) A candidate who after having passed B.A.LL.B. Part-III, First Semester examination of the university has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the B.A.LL.B. Part-III Second semester summer term examination.
- (vi) A candidate who after having passed B.A.LL.B. Part-III Second semester examination of the university or of any other statutory university recognized as equivalent thereto, has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the B.A.LL.B. Part-IV First semester winter term examination.
- (vii) A candidate who after having passed B.A.LL.B. Part-IV First semester examination of the university has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the B.A.LL.B. Part-IV, Second semester summer term examination.
- (viii) A candidate who after having passed B.A.LL.B. Part-IV, Second semester examination of the university or of any other statutory university recognized as equivalent thereto, has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the B.A.LL.B. Part-V, First semester winter term examination.
- (ix) A candidate who after having passed B.A.LL.B. Part-V, First semester examination of the university has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of

law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the B.A.LL.B. Part-V, Second semester summer term examination.

Provided, however that a student who after having passed B.A.LL.B. Part-I, (First semester and Second semester) or B.A.LL.B. Part-II, (First semester and Second semester) or B.A.LL.B. Part-III, (First semester and Second semester) or B.A.LL.B. Part-IV, (First semester and Second semester) examination from another University is admitted to B.A.LL.B. Part-II, First Semester or B.A.LL.B. Part-III, First Semester or B.A.LL.B. Part-IV, First Semester or B.A.LL.B. Part-V, First Semester, as the case may be shall be required to pass in those papers/subjects which were included in the syllabus B.A.LL.B. Part-I, (First Semester and Second Semester) or B.A.LL.B. Part-II, (First Semester and Second Semester) or B.A.LL.B. Part-IV, (First Semester and Second Semester) or B.A.LL.B. Part-V, (First Semester and Second Semester) of this University but were not prescribed for the corresponding examinations of such other University. Such student shall not be declared successful at the B.A.LL.B. Part-V (Second Semester) Examination until he/she has in addition to the papers prescribed for the said examination passed at the subjects referred to in this proviso.

Provided further that a student, who after having passed B.A.LL.B. Part-I, Semester examination or B.A.LL.B. Part-II Semester examination or B.A.LL.B. Part-III Semester examination or B.A.LL.B. Part-IV Semester examination from another university is admitted to B.A.LL.B. Part-II, First Semester or B.A.LL.B. Part-III, First Semester or B.A.LL.B. Part-IV, First Semester or B.A.LL.B. Part-V, First Semester, as the case may be exempted in the said examination from appearing in those papers/subjects which he/she had offered at his/her previous examination in the other University and had passed therein.

(a) No student shall be permitted to appear for any of the B.A.LL.B. Semester examination unless he has attended at least 75% of the total number of lectures, practical works and Seminars held during the Semester Session. The Vice-Chancellor may condone 15% of attendance on the recommendation of Head of SON/Principal in genuine cases.

(b) Every student of the College/University Teaching Department Seeking admission to the Semester examination shall submit through the principal or Head of the Department as the case may be, application in prescribed form together with necessary fees. The student shall be permitted to appear in the examination if he fulfill other condition of ordinance/statutes of university relating to the examination.

9. (a) In order to declare successful at any of the B.A.L.L.B. Semester Examination every Candidate will have to obtain at least 40% marks in individual papers and at least 50% marks in aggregate.

Provided that for the purpose of declaration of the result of Candidate appearing B.A.L.L.B. Part V, Second Semester Examination, the marks obtained by them in the written examination as well as in practical/viva-voce shall be taken into account.

A successful candidate shall be assigned division on the basis of the marks obtained by him/her in all the ten semester examinations taken together. Those who secure 60% marks or more shall be placed in the FIRST DIVISION. All other successful Candidate shall be placed in the SECOND DIVISION.

(b) A candidate who has been declared unsuccessful in a semester examination may re-appear for the same subsequently as ex-student without being required to attend regular course of study for the same semester and he/she will be eligible for regular admission in the next semester only after passing the examination meant for the previous semester.

(c) A candidate who is failed in one paper/subject in a semester shall be allowed to take admission in the subsequent semester and shall appear in the paper/subject in which he/she has been unsuccessful in the previous semester along with the all papers/subject of next semester in which he is admitted on regular basis. Such a repeater candidate will be provided facility of clearing all the papers up to eight semesters. No candidate will be allowed regular admission in the ninth semester until he/she clears all the papers/subjects from first semester to eighth semester.

(d) A candidate who has secured minimum passing marks in all the papers but could not obtain the 50% of the total marks will be eligible for admission at the next semester and will be provided the facility of continued admission up to eight semester like the repeater candidate and he/she will have to make up the 50% of the total aggregate of marks in each semester than only he/she will be qualified for regular admission in the ninth semester. Such candidate shall be given option to select any two papers/subjects of the concern semester to make up to the shortfall of the 50% each semester.

10. (a) There shall be provision for revaluation after each semester examination and the candidate can apply in maximum two papers only.

(b) V.C. grace marks as per rule will be granted in the student if needed, in final result making.

11. The conditions/stipulations of above ordinance will be subject to rules and regulation made or modified by the Bar Council of India in respect of Rules of Legal Education as framed and amended from time to time.

12. The provision of Ordinances 5 and 6 shall be applicable only to the extent that they are not inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance.
13. The Executive Council shall publish the result of the examination as soon as possible for it.
14. After passing all the Five Year examination, the candidate shall be eligible for the degree of B.A. LL.B. Five Year Integrated Degree Course, if permitted by the executive council.

SYLLABUS L.L.B

Bastar University Jagdalpur , Chhattisgarh
REVISED ORDINANCE NO. 180
L.L.B. THREE YEAR LAW DEGREE COURSE
(SEMESTER SYSTEM)

- (1) The course for the degree of the Bachelor of Laws (Semester System) under this ordinance shall extend over a period of three academic years comprising of six semesters in all, for each semester there shall be held an Examination in the paper prescribed for the said semester concerned.

These Semesters shall be called as –

- L.L.B. Part I – First Semester
- L.L.B. Part I – Second Semester
- L.L.B. Part II – First Semester
- L.L.B. Part II – Second Semester
- L.L.B. Part III – First Semester
- L.L.B. Part III – Second Semester

These semester examinations shall be held at Bastar and such other place as the Academic Council or the Executive Council may determine from time to time.

- (2) L.L.B. First Semester shall be commence from the month of July every year and the Semester examination shall be held in the month of January of the following year. Examination for all the semester shall be held twice a year namely January/February and July/August.

- (3) (a) A Candidate who after having passed Bachelors Degree Course Examination in any discipline or any other equivalent examination with at least 45% (40% marks in case of SC/ST candidate) marks in aggregate and has prosecuted and has prosecuted a regular Course of Prescribed study for one semester session in the University Department of Law or any College affiliated to the university shall be eligible to appear at the L.L.B. – Part I, First Semester examination.

Provided that such a minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a person to get admission into an institution but only shall entitle the person concerned to fulfill other institutional criteria notified by the institution concerned or by the Government concerned from time to time to apply for admission.

(b) Subject to the conditions contained in Para 5(a) to (d);

(i) A candidate who after having passed L.L.B. Part- First Semester examination of the university session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the L.L.B. Part-I Second semester examination.

(ii) A candidate who after having passed L.L.B. Part- I Second Semester examination of the university or of any other statutory university recognized as equivalent thereto, has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the L.L.B. Part- II First semester examination.

(iii) A candidate who after having passed L.L.B. Part- II First Semester examination of the university has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/ herself at the L.L.B. Part-II Second Semester examination.

(iv) a candidate who after having passed L.L.B. Part-II Second Semester examination of the university or of any other statutory university recognized as equivalent thereto, has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the L.L.B. Part - III First semester examination.

(v) A candidate who after having passed L.L.B. Part - III First Semester examination of the university has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the L.L.B. Part -III Second semester examination.

(v) A candidate who after having passed L.L.B. Part- III First Semester examination of the university has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the university department of law or in an affiliated college to the university shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the L.L.B. Part-III second semester examination.

Provided, however that a student who after having passed L.L.B. Part-I (First Semester and Second Semester) or L.L.B. Part-II(First Semester and Second Semester) Semester examination from another University is admitted to L.L.B. Part- II, First Semester or L.L.B. Part-III, First Semester, as the case may be shall also be required to pass in those papers/subjects which were included in the syllabus L.L.B. Part-I (First Semester and Second Semester) or L.L.B. Part-II (First Semester and Second Semester) of this University but were not prescribed for the corresponding examinations of such other University. Such student shall not be declared successful at the L.L.B. Part- III (First Semester or Second Semester) Examination until he/she has in addition to the papers prescribed for the said examination passed in the subjects referred to in this proviso.

Provided further that a student, who after having passed L.L.B. Part-I Semester examination or L.L.B. Part-II Semester examination from another university is admitted to L.L.B. Part-II, First Semester or L.L.B. Part-III, First Semester, as the case may be exempted in the said examination from appearing in those papers/subjects which he/she had offered at his/ her previous examination in the other University and had passed therein.

(4) (a) No Candidate shall be permitted to appear for any of the L.L.B. Semester examination unless he has attended at least 75% of the total number of lectures, Practical works and seminars held during the Semester Session.

(b) Every student of the college/University Teaching Department Seeking admission to the examination shall submit through the principal or head of the Department as the case may be, application on prescribed form together with necessary fees and following certificates from the Principal/head of the Department viz. Certificates of-

(i) Good Conduct,

(ii) Fitness to present, himself/herself at the examination and,

(iii) Of having ended the class teacher's Seminars and practical works etc. during the session at least the minimum number prescribed by sub-Para (a) above.

(5) (a) In order to declare successful at any of the L.L.B. Semester Examination every Candidate will have to obtain at least 36% marks in individual papers and at least 48% marks in aggregate.

Provided that for the purpose of declaration of the result of Candidate appearing L.L.B. Part III Second Semester Examination the marks obtained by them in the written examination as well as in practical/viva-voce shall be taken into account.

A successful candidate shall be assigned division on the basis of the marks obtained by him/her in all the six semester examinations taken together. Those who secure 60% marks or more shall be placed in the FIRST DIVISION. All other successful Candidate shall be placed in the SECOND DIVISION.

(b) A candidate who has been declared unsuccessful as a semester examination may re-appear for the same subsequently as ex-student without being required to attend regular course of study for the same semester and he/she will be eligible for regular admission in the next semester only after passing the examination meant for the previous semester.

(c) A candidate who is failed in one paper/subject in a semester shall be allowed to take admission in the subsequent semester and shall appear in the paper/subject in which he/she has been unsuccessful in the previous semester along with the all papers/subject of next semester in which he is admitted on regular basis. Such a repeater candidate will be provided facility of clearing all the papers up to fourth semester. No candidate will be allowed regular admission in the fifth semester until he/she clears all the papers/subject from first semester to fourth semester.

(d) A candidate who has secured minimum passing marks in all the papers but could not obtain the 48% of the total marks will be eligible for admission at the next semester and will be provided the facility of continued admission up to fourth semester like the repeater candidate and he/she will have to make up the 48% of the total aggregate of marks in each semester than only he/she will be qualified for regular admission in the fifth semester. Such candidate shall be given option to select any two papers/subject of the concern semester to make up to the shortfall of the 48% each semester.

(6) Subject to the condition stipulated by a university, and the general social condition of the applicants seeking legal education belatedly, the maximum age for seeking admission into a stream of three Year Bachelor Degree Course in Law, is limited to thirty years with right of the university to give concession of 5 further year for the applicant belonging to SC or ST or any other backward community.

Thus, the maximum age for seeking admission into a stream of three years bachelor degree course in law will be 30 years for the General Category of Candidate and 35 years to the candidate belonging to the ST, SC and OBC classes, on the 1st day of July every year.

(7) The conditions/ stipulations of above ordinance will be subject to rules and regulations made or modified by the Bar Council of India in respect of Rules of Legal Education as framed and amended from time to time. For the above purpose the other ordinance relating to the examination of the university shall also apply.

(8) The Executive Council shall publish the results of the examination as soon as possible for it.
