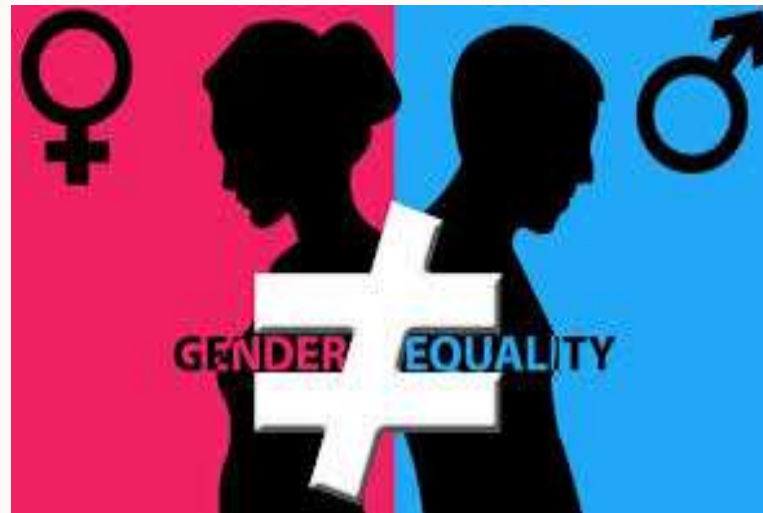

COSTS OF DISCRIMINATION

- Loss of GDP in US:
 - Racial discrimination: 4%
 - Gender discrimination: 3%
- Loss of GDP in India:
 - Gender discrimination: 4%
