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LANGUAGE AS A SCHOOL SUBJECT

- ◉ Language - Introduction
- ◉ Medium to communicate/express our thoughts, ideas, feelings etc to others
- ◉ Preservation of thoughts or knowledge
- ◉ Transference of knowledge to next generation
- ◉ An electric wire that provides power to the whole school system
- ◉ It acts as an identity of schools

FUNCTIONS OF LANGUAGE

- ◉ Instrumental
language is used to communicate preferences, choices, wants, or needs
 - ◉ Personal
language is used to express individuality
 - ◉ Interactional
language is used to interact and plan, develop, or maintain a play or group activity or social relationship
- ◉ "I want to ..."
 - ◉ "Here I am"
 - ◉ "You and me"
"I'll be the cashier,"

Function

- Regulatory
language is used to control
- Representational
Use language to explain
- Heuristic language is used to find things out, wonder, or hypothesize
- Imaginative
language is used to create, explore, and entertain

Examples

- "Do as I tell you"
- "You need"
- "I'll tell you."
- "I know."
- "Tell me why"
- "Why did you do that?"
- "What for?"
- "Let's pretend"
- "I went to my grandma's last night."

Language as a school subject

- ◉ Centre of all school subjects
- ◉ Not the language spoken by students in school
- ◉ Language taught in schools are official languages of state/nation
- ◉ Those that have economic, cultural, political values become subjects
- ◉ Traditionally language subjects were called as service subjects
- ◉ Now language education has distinct value
- ◉ Teaching of language aims at developing the knowledge of various aspects of language.

Language as medium of instruction

- ◉ Languages used by schools for transaction of curriculum
- ◉ In Kerala language as medium of instruction is Malayalam
- ◉ Instruction may be monolingual, bilingual, multilingual or translingual
- ◉ LMI is decided by the school governing bodies
